Devon Rushnell is a 1988 graduate of Florida State University with a degree in Civil Engineering. Mr. Rushnell has more than 35 years of engineering, planning, acquisition, entitlement, land development and related homebuilding experience. He began his career as a geotechnical engineer in Jacksonville, Florida and later converted to civil design, Devon gained valuable insight into the multiple disciplines of engineering and a working knowledge of land from phase 1 environmental studies, foundation analysis, community layout and design to the extensive process necessary for land entitlements.

Devon's land development and homebuilding career began in 1996 spanning three national homebuilders over the next six years advancing to full management responsibility for the Tampa Division of Beazer Homes. In January 2002, Devon teamed with Jack Suarez (President and Founder of Inland Homes) to create LandBuilder Corporation. In the robust market upswing LandBuilder created unique communities ranging from Carroll Landing (a custom infill project in Carrollwood), to North Park Isles (a 400-acre master planned community in eastern Hillsborough County). Through the down market, Devon served as Vice President of Land Resources for Taylor Morrison responsible for numerous land acquisitions along the West Coast of Florida. Throughout his career, Devon has been actively involved in over one hundred land development projects resulting in the creation of over 15,000 residential lots for new home construction.

LandBuilder was re-born in May of 2013 with a focused approach to build a land development company consisting of multiple local partnerships handling small and larger developments under our governance and leadership.

Devon is a 1995 graduate of Leadership Brevard, holds a current Florida Professional Engineering license, and is a past Vice President & President of the Florida Engineering Society and American Society of Civil Engineers.
